ABOUT DARUL ULOOM

Darul Uloom Darul Yatama, located near Lautoka City, Fiji, has been committed to Islamic education and welfare since 1972. Originally known as Drasa Madrasa, it began with a mission to educate and care for orphans and disadvantaged students. Under the leadership of the late Mr. Ameer Khan, the institution started with just four students and gradually expanded. In 1997, Principal Maulana Khalid Hussain introduced the Hifzul-Quran and Al Alimiya courses, enhancing academic rigor. A major milestone was achieved in 2018 when the institution was officially registered as a training center by the Fiji Higher Education Commission. Today, it serves students from Fiji, Australia, Kiribati, Vanuatu, and the Solomon Islands, offering both Islamic and secular education. With its vocational center now registered, the institution is working to introduce Vocational Education Courses. Managed by the Islamia Tablighi Jamat of Fiji, Darul Uloom Darul Yatama continues to rely on donor support to sustain its mission of education and care.

MISSION

To provide a challenging Islamic teaching and learning environment that will nurture and empower the child to become creative and mould just and disciplined society which can positively pursue and develop a future for themselves, the community and the country as a whole.

VISION

To develop a future generation of learners who are able to practice, teach and propagate Islam according to the commandments of the Holy Qur'an and Sunnah of the Holy Prophet (SAW), and are able to link and work together harmoniously and consciously in a multicultural and multi-religious society like Fiji.

FACULTIES

The Darul Uloom has three main faculties of studies in order to cater for the social, cultural, moral, spiritual, intellectual and physical development of our students. The coursework prepares students to become upright citizens with the aptitude to become Imams (Priest), school teachers and administrators of Islamic Institutions.

MASTERS - ISLAMIC STUDIES (DARS-E-NIZAMI)

Dars-e-Nizami is a comprehensive seven-year curriculum widely implemented in Islamic seminaries (madrasas) and educational institutions. This traditional Islamic education program offers extensive religious and theological education. Its structure encompasses various Islamic sciences and disciplines, enabling students to gain a well-rounded understanding, practice, and propagate the teachings of Islam.

DIPLOMA - MEMORIZATION OF THE HOLY QURAN (HIFZ-UL-QURAN)

The "Diploma in Memorization of the Holy Quran" is a comprehensive and structured educational program designed to facilitate the memorization (Tahfiz) of the entire Quran, the sacred scripture of Islam. This program is tailored to help students develop a deep and meaningful connection with the Quran while mastering the art of memorization.

CERTIFICATE - DEENIYAAT COURSE

This two-year part-time program is designed for students in Years 11 and 12 who wish to deepen their understanding of Deeniyaat (religious studies). The course integrates the memorization of selected Surahs from the Holy Quran, and comprehensive exploration of the Deeniyaat and Taalim and Tarbiyat

curriculum. Students will also develop practical skills in delivering sermons, leading daily and special prayers, and delivering speeches.

PART-TIME ISLAMIC COURSES

The Institute offers a variety of part-time Islamic courses suitable for students of all ages, from school-going children to working adults. These courses are structured into easily understandable lessons, with classes scheduled at convenient times to accommodate everyone's needs.

PART-TIME MAKTAB (YOUTH PROGRAM)

The Part-Time Maktab is designed for school-aged children and operates during the afternoons after school and on Saturdays. This program aims to provide a comprehensive Islamic education.

DARUL ULOOM LADIES SECTION

To provide the mothers and sisters of our community with religious and spiritual education, Madrasa Aisha Lil Banaat has been serving the Muslim community for several years. We offer various courses for women, including Fiqh classes, Qur'an and Tafseer classes, and other subjects related to religious education.

ADULT MALE CLASSES

Our adult male Maktab classes focus on essential aspects of Islam, including Noorani Qaida, Qur'an, Salah, and other fundamental teachings. These classes are designed to enhance religious knowledge and practice among adult men in our community.
